Our Impact

Last year, The Bowery Mission served over **400,000** hot meals, provided **65,000** nights of shelter and **40,000** emergency showers, and distributed **27,000** articles of clothing to NYC neighbors in need. Our Residential Programs helped more than **150** adults rebuild their lives after homelessness, while our Children’s Programs empowered hundreds of kids from NYC’s underserved neighborhoods to grow in character and faith.

Compassionate Care For Neighbors in Crisis

Within our red doors, anyone in crisis is welcomed to hot meals, safe shelter, chapel services, showers, clothing, and support from a social worker – all tangible expressions of God’s love. Through small acts of kindness, we aim to build trust, reignite hope, and equip guests with next steps on their journey to recovery and independence.

Residential Programs for Adults

Men and women recovering from homelessness become part of a transformational community dedicated to helping them heal from past trauma, overcome life’s obstacles, and regain independence. Through counseling and classes, clients gain support for renewing faith, rebuilding relationships, restoring health, developing life skills, and securing employment and housing.

Caring Support for Children & Families

In our children’s programs—Mont Lawn Camp and City Camp—kids from NYC’s most underserved neighborhoods find a safe and welcoming place to explore their talents, build lifelong friendships, and grow in character and faith. Year-round enrichment classes and mentoring culminate in an unforgettable week at our summer camp.
