Multinational teams join the 2022 TCS New York City Marathon to help raise funds for The Bowery Mission

New York, NY, November 4, 2022 — Three teams - American, French and Australian are running in this year's New York City Marathon to raise funds for The Bowery Mission, which for more than 150 years, has been providing food and overnight shelter to New Yorkers experiencing homelessness.

The three running teams bring together long-time friends and supporters of the Mission, and staff members with a goal to raise critical funds for The Bowery Mission's programs.

"For me, running the NYC marathon for The Bowery Mission transforms a solitary sport into a collective and meaningful experience," said Alain Bernard, a leader in global luxury markets.
